Read Every Day



Your child will receive a coloured reading card from their class teacher. Please record the date, book title and pages read as well as any other comments you wish to make in one of the squares.

Teachers check these cards weekly and stamp them to show they have been looked at. Every class will also have a red post box near the classroom door for you to use if you have any written messages or queries (these do not just need to relate to reading!) for the classteacher.

The RED cards show helpful hints in how you can support your child with their reading. These take the form of 'I can' statements. Your child will also be working on these in school.

If your child reads at home for more than 20 times they receive a special award from Mrs King.

Read Every Day



We have been running the Read Every Day reading cards for the past year. We have recently been talking to the children about what they think:

- They find the reading cards easy to understand
- They like receiving rewards for reading at home
- They would like extra rewards for those children who do lots of reading at home

As a result we are changing our reading rewards!

Children will continue to get a reward every time they read 20 times at home.

Children who read more than 20 times over each half term will get a special RED badge or medal at the end of the term.
